

Scholarship terms and conditions

This document outlines the Terms and Conditions for student scholarships administered by the Australian Society of Viticulture and Oenology (ASVO). Wine Industry House Cnr. Botanic and Hackney Rd, ADELAIDE 5000, A.B.N. 42 404 438 575

1. Scholarship Value

- 1.1. There are 3 x concessional registrations for ASVO seminars available. Registration provides full participation in the seminar including seminar materials, as well as morning, midday and afternoon refreshments. If a dinner is held in conjunction with the seminar, registration will cover the cost of entry to the dinner.

2. Eligibility

- 2.1. The scholarship is open to student members of the ASVO residing in Australia.
- 2.2. One application per student member is allowed.
- 2.3. Applicants may register to become a new member and therefore be able to submit an application.
- 2.4. The Scholarship excludes employees and their immediate families of ASVO, their agents or anyone professionally connected to the promotion.
- 2.5. The ASVO reserves the right to verify the eligibility of entrants. The ASVO may require such information as it considers reasonably necessary for the purpose of verifying the eligibility of an entry and the award may be withheld until and unless the ASVO (in its sole discretion) is satisfied with the verification. The ASVO's decision is final.
- 2.6. A submission for a scholarship is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions.

3. Accepting a scholarship

- 3.1. Successful applicants will be contacted by email in May.
- 3.2. The award is non-transferable. No cash alternative. In the unlikely event of the seminar not proceeding, the ASVO reserves the right to defer the offer.
- 3.3. Successful applicants' must supply a personal profile (including a photograph) for display on the ASVO website for a period of 1 year after the scholarship is awarded.
- 3.4. If the successful applicant is not able to attend the seminar for any reason, the scholarship will be forfeited.

4. Specific criteria

- 4.1. Scholarships are awarded based on established eligibility criteria. You must meet the eligibility requirements to be considered. The eligibility requirements for each award are outlined in section 2 of this document.

5. Previous scholarship recipients

- 5.1. An applicant will be awarded only one (1) ASVO scholarship within any two-year period.

6. Disqualifications

- 6.1. No entrant can use their computer, via brute force or script, to enable multiple entries or multiple accounts or to undermine the application process. In this event that person's entry and all other associated entries will be disqualified and any award will be withheld.
- 6.2. No third-party entries, or entries submitted by agents will be accepted. No incomplete or corrupted entries will be accepted. In this event, that person's entry will be disqualified and any award will be void. Any malicious or manipulative attempt to influence the application process will result in disqualification at the sole discretion of the ASVO. If there is any reason to believe that there has been a breach of these Terms and Conditions or incorrect, illegible, fraudulent or other invalid or improper information has been provided the ASVO may at its sole discretion refuse to fulfil the award.
- 6.3. Invalid, incomprehensible, corrupt, obscene, provocative or otherwise questionable details in the application will be disregarded and users disqualified without notice. The ASVO retains sole discretion as to what constitutes inappropriate content.

7. Responsibilities

- 7.1. The ASVO is not responsible for any data lost, damaged, delayed either inbound or outbound, any erroneous electronic transmissions, or information not received online, or for network, computer hardware or software failures of any kind that is caused by any circumstance beyond its reasonable control or by any act or omission of any third party, which may restrict or delay entry although it will always use reasonable endeavours to minimise any entrant disappointment.
- 7.2. All entrants will be deemed to have accepted and be bound by these terms and conditions and any requirements set out in the accompanying promotional material.
- 7.3. Owing to exceptional circumstances outside its reasonable control and only where circumstances make this unavoidable, the ASVO reserves the right to cancel or amend the promotion or these terms and conditions at any stage but will always endeavour to minimise the effect to participants in order to avoid undue disappointment.
